CEO Report	<p>Sandra Cripps provided an overview of SASWH's programs and services and highlighted some of the work and achievements from 2017 including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The majority of injuries continue to be shoulder and back. • The premium rate will remain at \$1.60, although WCB is subsidizing the healthcare sector by \$0.02 in 2018 only to keep it at its current rate. • Uptake on our programs and services has accelerated in 2017. Employees receiving training from SASWH has also increased significantly. • We are on target for meeting the strategic priorities.

Bylaw Changes</p>	<p>The following proposed changes to the Bylaws were brought forward for approval:</p> <p>Section 1.1 - Definitions (last paragraph)</p> <p>“WCB G22 Rate Code” means a specific group of employers classified according to the Saskatchewan Workers’ Compensation Board. G22 is the group of health service providers in the province including, for example, health regions, private care homes, emergency services, and long term care homes. The current list of G22 members is available through WCB and in the Saskatchewan Association for Safe Workplaces in Health (SASWH) Policy Manual.</p> <p><u>Amendment</u>: Replace reference to “health regions” with “Saskatchewan Health Authority”.</p> <p>Section 6.1 - Board Structure</p> <p>b) Portion relating to Worker Directors</p> <p>Five (5) Worker Directors appointed by the individual unions as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> One (1) Canadian Union of Public Employees One (1) Health Sciences Association of Saskatchewan One (1) Service Employees International Union West One (1) Saskatchewan Government and General Employees’ Union One (1) Saskatchewan Union of Nurses <p>One (1) Worker Director as appointed by the five worker/worker representatives:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> One (1) Worker Director at Large <p><u>Amendment</u>: Remove line above number 6 referring to “One (1) Director at Large as appointed by the five worker/worker representatives” as it appears to identify 7 Board members</p>	<p>MOTION: To approve the proposed changes to the Bylaws as presented. In the absence of a quorum, the remaining Directors shall, as soon as possible, call a meeting of members to fill the vacancy.</p> <p><u>Amendment:</u> "If a vacancy occurs on the Board, the remaining Directors may appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy in the category in question. In the absence of a quorum, the remaining Directors shall, as soon as possible, call a meeting of members to fill the vacancy".</p> <p>b) If the number of elected or appointed Directors is increased, a vacancy or vacancies on the Board equal to the number of the authorized increase shall thereby be deemed to have occurred.
