This program is specific for the field of EMS working in *uncontrolled* environments (e.g., private residences, outside) and has been developed through collaboration with the Saskatchewan Health Authority EMS. TLR EMS is one part of an employer’s comprehensive program to address injuries related to the moving task.

Taught by SASWH approved TLR EMS trainers, classroom training facilitates discussion, problem-solving and hands-on practice of the risk assessment process and safe moving techniques/guidelines specific for the EMS sector. For information on SASWH’s TLR EMS program, email info@saswh.ca.

TLR EMS Lift Sheet

In collaboration with Saskatchewan Health Authority EMS, and with dedicated funding from Saskatchewan Ministry of Health (Acute and Emergency Services Branch), SASWH is pleased to provide new patient lift sheets for each active ambulance in Saskatchewan.

Prior to putting the lift sheet into service, workers watch an educational video to support orientation and training on equipment. Focus on safety: submit a safety story (200 words +/-) on how you have utilized the lift sheet in various situations, creating and supporting a safe moving task for yourself, your co-worker and patient.

Photo supplement: a photo of yourself and your co-worker is invited, but not required (e.g., with the lift sheet). Include as sizable picture file - jpg or png.

Confidentiality: **do not** submit pictures, names or any identifier of patients, private residences, description of the case that may identify a patient, areas where clinical care was provided, or others not employed in Saskatchewan EMS. All submissions will be reviewed and if necessary, edited by SASWH to exclude any reference to confidential information. It must be clear that you are not speaking on behalf of your employer, but as a health care professional in your field, building trust and confidence.

Contest deadline: submissions received before midnight Saturday, May 29, 2021, will be accepted.

Random draw: six (6) random draws will take place the week of May 31, 2021, from all eligible entries received. Winners will be notified by phone or email. Enter as often as you wish; each entry must be its own safety story and submitted separately.
